B. Budget – Superintendent Green stated that they are still working on the numbers to determine what the total budget will be. The savings in insurance is going to be offset by the expenses for LRTC, Maine Paid Family Leave Act and one other item. The majority of the savings is going to be taken up by those cost. As far as LD974, Ed Tech minimum salaries; we have looked at our salaries and there are a couple of positions currently that are below the percentage. Superintendent Green stated that he received an email from MSMA stating that they will be giving some clarification on some of the wording but this does not take effect until July 1, 2025. We will have renegotiated by then and hopefully have an agreement in place by 2025 and will be able to look at what positions those are. The only positions that were a little below were the cafeteria assistant and Ed Tech I's which we have not hired in years, but we do have a couple that are study hall monitors at the high school. Depending what the increase is on the next contract, there may be a couple of Ed Tech II's that would need approximately 15-20 cents.

Superintendent Green stated that he has not received any feedback / suggestions regarding the budget.

C. Comprehensive Ed Plan – Superintendent Green reviewed the plan item by item. Superintendent Green also reminded the board that they needed to assign a member to review this plan as it was left vacant and unfilled.
