

STUDENT ASSESSMENT

The Lisbon School Committee recognized that Maine law requires each school administrative unit to use multiple assessment methods to measure student growth and proficiency in the content areas of the Learning Results and the cross-curricular *Guiding Principles*. The Lisbon School Committee also recognized the value of assessment in informing and improving instruction.

Through this policy, the Lisbon School Committee adopts and directs the Superintendent and/or the Director of Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment to implement and oversee an assessment system for the Lisbon School Department that will accomplish these objectives. The Superintendent and/or the Director of Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment shall be responsible for reviewing the assessment system for the compliance with applicable statutes and Department of Education Standards.
